



Temporary Membership Supervisory Agreement

Pursuant to the ***Act to Incorporate the New Brunswick Association of Social Workers 1988*** and the By-Laws as approved by the Association in May, 1989 and amendments thereafter,

the following agreement is made between:

a Registered Social Worker (hereinafter called the "Supervisor") **(please print)**

and:

a Temporary member of the NBASW **(please print)**

The Supervisor agrees to assume responsibility for the professional practice of the Temporary member and both the Supervisor and the Temporary member agree that the following **conditions of supervision** will be fulfilled and proof of adherence to these conditions will be provided to the Association upon request. The temporary agreement terminates on _____ at which time the Temporary member should be a member in good standing or should cease to practice social work.

1. The Supervisor must be a member in good standing of the NBASW.
2. The Supervisor must have two years of related experience obtained within the last ten years, in the field of practice that the Temporary member will be entering.
3. The Supervisor shall be readily available for case consultation either in person or by telephone.
4. Weekly supervisory sessions shall be held, reviewing the practice of the Temporary member.
5. Monthly reviews of the Temporary member's documentation practices shall be held.
6. The Supervisor will take reasonable steps to monitor the Temporary member's adherence to the **New Brunswick Association of Social Workers Code of Ethics 2007** and report any apparent violations to the NBASW.
